SMLS Goes Green

Making green choices fits with the value system that is being promoted among the student body about being environmentally conscious.

The decision to incorporate LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) Certification in the new construction at St. Mildred's-Lightbourn School is a significant investment in our natural world and ensures that our girls are provided with a healthy environment to learn and succeed. The School will have the added benefit of saving costs for heating, lighting and cooling, providing a positive return on the building investment.

Sustainability

Sustainable designs and practices will be part of our daily life. Reusable cutlery and glasses, and biodegradable, compostable, or recyclable products are being considered for use in the kitchen and dining hall.

Improved air quality

Indoor air quality will be improved through natural ventilation and by integrating products with low harmful emission rates.

Energy efficient

The new structure integrates the inside with the outside providing 90% of the interior spaces with exterior views. Daylight reduces dependence on artificial lighting.
